

#### 2024 Notice Formulary Drug List Changes - 5 Tier Effective 07/01/2024

Community Health Plan of Washington<sup>™</sup> may add or remove drugs from our formulary during the year. If we remove drugs from our formulary, or add prior authorization, quantity limits and/or step therapy restrictions on a drug, we will notify you of the change at least 60 days before the date that the change becomes effective. However, if the Food and Drug Administration deems a drug on our formulary to be unsafe or the drug's manufacturer removes the drug from the market we will immediately remove the drug from our formulary. #### **List of Abbreviations**

LA: Limited Availability. This medication may only be available at certain pharmacies.

**PA:** Prior Authorization. The Plan requires you or your physician to get prior authorization for certain medications. This means that you will need to get approval before you fill your prescriptions. If you don't get approval, we may not cover the medication.

QL: Quantity Limit. For certain drugs, the Plan limits the amount of the medication that we will cover.

**ST:** Step Therapy. In some cases, the Plan requires you to try certain drugs first to treat your medical condition before we will cover another drug for that condition.
